Type 1 Objection

If you do not want information that identifies you to be shared outside your GP practice, for purposes beyond your direct care, tick this box.

This prevents your personal confidential information from being used other than in particular circumstances required by law, such as a public health emergency like an outbreak of a pandemic disease.

Summary Care Record (SCR) Opt Out

A national electronic record (SCR) is used to support patient care. It contains key information from your GP record. Your SCR provides authorised healthcare staff with faster, secure access to essential information about you in an emergency or when you need unplanned care, where such information would otherwise be unavailable.

If you wish to opt-out of having an SCR tick this box.

Local Record Opt Out (Bucks-My Care Record/Berks-Connect Care)

If you require attention from e.g. Emergency Department, Minor Illness and Injury Unit, NHS111, Out Of Hours location, or specialised local health and social care team, those treating you are better able to give appropriate care if information from your GP patient record is available to them. The core information of the Summary Care Record comprises your allergies, adverse reactions and medications. This information can be locally shared electronically via My Care Record or Connect Care.

If you wish to opt-out of My Care Record (Buckinghamshire patients) or Connect Care (Berkshire patients), tick this box.

Risk Stratification

Risk stratification is a process for identifying and managing patients who are most likely to need hospital or other healthcare services in the future. Unidentifiable, anonymised information about patients is collected from a number of NHS organisations and then analysed. This should improve care for everyone by helping practices to work more proactively by planning healthcare in advance.
